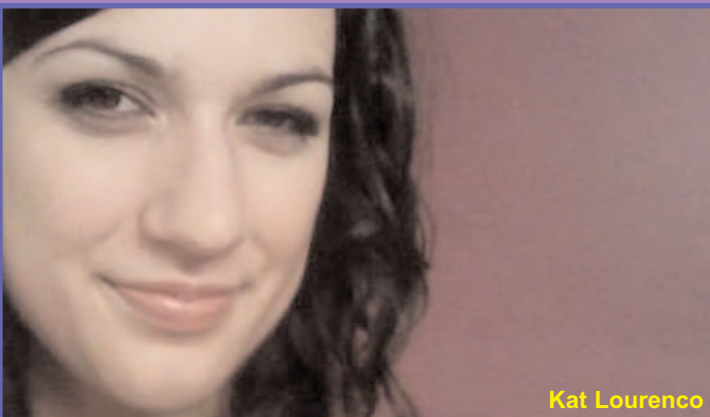
### Sperling Wins \$3,500
