

Seven Leaders Join Harris Faculty

Andy Hermant, Lenny DeRose, Andy Malcolm, Fergus Hambleton, Brent Haliskie, John Thomson & Michael Nunan have joined the Producing/Engineering Program (PEP) faculty.

Andy Hermant founded the world-renowned Manta Sound Company (Canada's first digital multi-track studio), Duke Street Records and 1:2:1 Recording. He engineered the No. 1 Billboard hit by Dan Hill, was the CBC's Manager of Post Production for 13 years and has served on the Boards of CARAS, CIRPA, FACTOR, The Canadian Film Centre and Roy Thomson and Massey Halls.

Juno Award winner for Recording Engineer of the Year, Lenny DeRose has recorded over 60 albums including Motley Crue, Liona Boyd, Alice Cooper, Strange Advance, 54-40, Celine Dion, Edwin, Long John Baldry, Fefe Dobson, Helix and has worked on the soundtracks for Naked in New York and 9 1/2 Weeks. He has produced every recording by The Philosopher Kings.

Andy Malcolm is a Genie, Gemini and Golden Reel award-winning Foley Artist. He has been nominated for or won 29 awards and is considered one of the world's leading Foley Artists. He has per-

formed foley in over 150 feature films including The Naked Lunch, Crash, Nascar 3D Imax, Ali, American Psycho, Austin Powers in Goldmember, The Cave, Bewitched and Meet The Fockers.

Juno Award winner Fergus Hambleton is a singer, songwriter, multi-instrumentalist and producer. With 6 albums and numerous national and international awards, he has fronted the Sattalites for twenty-five years and released 3 solo albums for Capital/EMI and Axe Records. Selections from his album Snapshots are featured in the film Falling Angels and the TV program The L Word.
